After joining TorPharm Inc. (a division of Apotex Inc.) in 1993, Daryn Tsuji began a career spanning 15 years in increasingly senior positions including IS Operations Applications Manager; IS Leader, Delivery Team; Technical Account Manager, Information Services; and Principal Consultant.

As IS Operations Applications Manager, Daryn led a group of five IT professionals supporting all aspects of the TorPharm network. He created and implemented standard procedures aligned with GAMP to govern computer validation efforts. He was also responsible for the creation and tracking of budgetary matters.

In the IS Leader role, Daryn was accountable for all IS activities in the commissioning, validation, and turnover of a new oral solid dose manufacturing facility capable of producing 5 billion dosages per year. This facility was chosen as one of 5 finalists for the 2005 global award for “Facility of the Year” by ISPE, INTERPHEX and Pharmaceutical Processing. Drawing on his experience with computer validation, Daryn provided guidance as part of the Validation Steering Committee to the overall validation of the facility.

Daryn occupied the IT CRM role of Technical Account Manager for the Corporate Services departments of Apotex including Human Resources, Finance, and Corporate Engineering. He was instrumental in several initiatives that increased efficiencies and removed redundant processes through the analysis and re-design of disparate workflows into a single cohesive workflow. Training of the relevant resources and communication of the new process to the rest of business were also key responsibilities of this role.

In the role of Principal Consultant, Daryn analyzed business processes and translated them into TrackWise configurations. Designing and implementing the TrackWise architecture for various projects gave him experience in TrackWise 6.0 and 7.0.

Daryn is currently working at Apotex supporting configuration and process activities for TrackWise. He is also designing and implementing TrackWise reports through Crystal Reports XI.
